This is in response to your appeal regarding the revocation of your security clearance eligibility. It was the decision of the USAF Personnel Security Appeal Board (PSAB) to grant the appeal of your security clearance and eligibility for assignment to a sensitive position.

On XX Feb 2014 the PSAB received the documents associated with your personal appearance before the Defense Office of Hearings and Appeals (DOHA) Administrative Judge. Your appeal was processed in accordance with DoD 5200.2-R and AFI 31-501, Chapter 8. All documentation pertaining to your appeal was thoroughly considered by the PSAB on XX March 2014. The PSAB determined that you did not knowingly ingest Oxycodone. Therefore, the PSAB concluded that the abuse of drugs, as indicated by the positive urinalysis test, happened under such circumstances that it is unlikely to recur and does not cast doubt on your reliability. In addition, you have demonstrated an intent to not to abuse any drugs in the future by signing a statement of future intent. This statement included a certification that you understood that any violation would result in the revocation of your security clearance.

This action is taken by the authority of the Secretary of the Air Force. The PSAB decision is final, and no other appeal rights are authorized.
